

COVID-19 4th Quarter Vaccination Implementation Plan

Unvaccinated

- You can get Pfizer and Moderna vaccination at trusted medical institution.
- * Non-holders of health insurance can be vaccinated at the vaccination center.
- AstraZeneca recipient: 1st dose vaccination is available for (30 years old above)
- Janssen: Basically, can be vaccinated for 50 years old above.
 - * 30 years old above, among recipients who are willing to get vaccinated twice and having difficulty, can contact the public health center, an immediate vaccination is available at designated vaccination institution.

Interval Adjustments for Moderna and Pfizer vaccination

- On the 2nd week of October (October 11th ~ October 17th), the schedule will be adjusted collectively from those who are reserved for 2nd dose vaccination.
 - A week advanced (6weeks → 5weeks) : From 2nd week of October ~ 1st week of November (October 11th ~ November 7th) 2nd dose expectant will be vaccinated.
 - Two weeks advanced(6weeks→4weeks) : From 2nd week of November (November 8th~November 14th) after the 2nd dose vaccination expectant.
- * If it is difficult to be vaccinated on the adjusted date and time due to personal circumstances, the schedule of vaccination can be change at the vaccination reservation website (<http://ncvr2.kdca.go.kr>) from October 1st (Fri.).
- After October, the 1st dose vaccine recipient can get 2nd dose vaccination, with Pfizer every 3 weeks and Moderna 4 weeks intervals.

Child and Adolescent Vaccination (Pfizer)

Target	16-17 years old (Who were born in 2004 – 2005)	12-15 years old (Who were born in 2006 – 2009)
Advance Reservation	October 5 th (Tue.) – October 29 th (Fri.)	October 18 th (Mon.) – November 12 th (Fri.)
Vaccination	October 18 th (Mon.) – November 13 th (Sat.)	November 1 st (Mon) – November 27 th (Sat.)

- * Based on the year of birth. Among 6th grader who were born in the year of 2010 are excluded.
- After making an individual or with proxy reservation, a consent of his/her guardian (legal representative) is needed for vaccination at designated medical institution.

Pregnant Women Vaccination (Self-decision)

- In case of underlying medical condition or first stage of pregnancy (below 12 weeks), the mother and fetus are recommended to be examined before the vaccination.
 - Reservation is available from October 8th (Fri.), medical staff must recognize pregnant woman's information*(pregnancy status, expected date of delivery), personally input the information when making reservation.
 - * In case the pregnant woman's information wasn't able to input (such as remaining vaccine, etc.) medical staff must be inform in advance when getting vaccinated at the vaccination center.
- Pfizer or Moderna vaccine will be conducted at the vaccination center (from October 18th(Mon.)~).
 - * In order to protect pregnant woman, people closely connected to her such as family member or people around her are requested to get vaccinated.

Additional Vaccination (Booster Shot)

- Two months after the basic vaccination completion, advance reservation for booster shot will start from October 18th (Mon.). And vaccination will start from November 1st (Mon.).
 - * Adults above 18 years old, who have difficulty forming immunity such as patients that under acute leukemia and patient undergoing immunosuppressive treatment etc., and difficulty forming immunity can reserve for booster shot.
- Workers who work in COVID-19 treatment hospital, nursing hospital, hospitalization facilities, or workers related to hospital must get booster shot at vaccination center.
- Advance reservation will start from October 5th(Tue.) for 60 years old above elderly and the other high-risk*group. (There are support aid such as proxy for reservation at the community centers, etc.)
 - * Booster shot will start from (October~), for those who are 75 years old above elderly, senior citizen facility (nursing home. community home for elders. day and night care. short-term care) related workers who started vaccination from April.

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
